



In winter, animals search hard for food. Rabbits nibble twigs that stick out of the snow. Deer looks for plants covered in snow. Birds eat left berries in tree branches.

**Migration** begins before winter. Animals leave colder areas and find other places. Due to warmer temperatures, monarch butterflies spend their winter days in Mexico and California.

**Hibernation** means deep sleep for animals in winter. Their breathing and heartbeats become slower. They use little energy because their body temperature is low. They survive through fats stored in their bodies.
